18 Holes, Better Ball Stableford for Gentlemen aged 60 and over on the day of the competition  
Enter in pairs, all entrants must have a COMPETITION (ACTIVE) handicap  
Handicap Limit for entry 24 - Stroke Allowance 90% of Handicap  
Not open to Gog Magog Golf Club members

### Seniors' Open Full Description & Terms of the Competition

#### Conditions:

18 Holes, Pairs Better Ball Stableford Play in accordance with the Rules of Golf and Club Rules. The Competition will be run under the jurisdiction of a Tournament Committee appointed by the Management Council of the Gog Magog Golf Club, whose decision affecting all matters in connection with this Competition shall be final.

In the event of a tie, the winner shall be determined by Countback, Last 9, 6, 3, 1.  
For the purposes of countback the back 9 is holes 10-18 on the scorecard.

Any competitor who, without the use of a buggy, could not enter the competition because of health reasons will need to comply with the club rules and submit a medical certificate & obtain prior authority from the competition committee. Competitors may use a buggy without a medical certificate but their team will not be eligible for any of the competition prizes.

#### Format:

Coffee and Bacon Roll on arrival  
Post golf 2 Course Lunch and Prize Presentation

#### Prizes:

Prizes for the 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th pairs over 18 holes.  
Prize for pair with Best Front Nine and Best Back Nine.  
Not more than one main prize will be allocated per entrant.  
Individual prizes for Nearest the Pin on all par 3's.  
Individual prize for the Longest Drive on Hole 12.

#### Entries:

Limited to 60 Pairs, for Gentlemen with playing handicaps of 24 or less.  
Stroke allowance 90% of Handicap.  
Minimum Age limit 60 (on the day of the competition).  
Closing date for entries Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> May 2019.

#### Entry Fee:

£79.00 per pair inclusive of morning coffee and bacon roll plus lunch (payable at entry)  
No refunds after the closing date.  
*The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.*

#### Tees:

Play will be from the White tees.

#### Start Times:

Two tee start using the 1st and 10th tees. Tee times from 08:30.  
Players select their own time and start point (1<sup>st</sup> or 10<sup>th</sup>) when entering online.
